## **Notice of Intent to Apply for Federal Assistance**

All interested parties are hereby advised that the Manatee County Board of County Commissioners is preparing to apply to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for capital and operating assistance grants under Section 5310 of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Act of 1964, as amended. The capital assistance grant application is for funding that will support preventive maintenance of the paratransit vehicle fleet. The operating assistance application is to provide funding to maintain the existing paratransit level of service.

Funding for both the capital and operating assistance grants are provided through the FTA Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities/Section 5310 Grant Program, for a total funding request of \$900,000 (\$650,000 capital and \$250,000 operating); and will be used for the provision of public transit services within the Manatee County Area Transit (MCAT) service area.

A Public Hearing is tentatively scheduled at the Transit Fleet Facility Large Conference Room, located at 2411 Tallevast Road, Sarasota, Florida 34243, on Friday, January 19, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. The purpose of advising all interested parties is to ensure that continued or proposed services do not result in duplication of services provided by existing public or private transit or para transit operators in the service area.

**This hearing will be conducted if and only if a written request for the hearing is received no later than 4 p.m. on Monday, January 12, 2018.**
