

## Park-and-Ride Service for the Cortez Seafood Festival

On Saturday, February 17<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Manatee County Area Transit (MCAT) buses will provide Park-and-Ride Shuttle service to and from the Cortez Seafood Festival, serving two parking locations: 1. The G.T. Bray Park (west entrance); and 2. The Coquina Beach bus turn-around. This Shuttle service is provided as a service enhancement for MCAT Route 6, serving the Cortez Road corridor. The MCAT Park-and-Ride Shuttles pick-up and drop-off Festival passengers from the designated parking locations from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM on each day of the Festival event. All other MCAT fixed route services continue to operate on their normal Saturday or Sunday schedule. The fare to use the Park-and-Ride Shuttle services are same as charged for the regular fixed-route service.
